Notice of Race

2008 505 / A-Cat Spring Open

Saturday-Sunday 4/26/2008-4/27/2008

1.0 Rules

- 1.1 The Regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS); the Class Rules of the International 505 Class and the A-Cat Class rules. (Except as any of these are modified by the Sailing Instructions)
- 1.2 US Sailing prescription to RRS 75.3 shall not apply.
- 1.3 RRS rule 40 is changed to require competitors to wear adequate personal flotation.

2 Eligibility and Entry

- 2.1 This Regatta is for 505 and A-Cat. The regatta is open to skippers representing a yacht club or association recognized by the International Sailing Federation (ISAF) or their national authority.
- 2.2 Eligible boats may register by completing the attached SCYC 2008 505 / A-Cat Spring open (EF), and presenting it with the required entry fee to the race committee between 1030 and 1100 hours in the SCYC clubhouse Saturday April 26, 2008.

3 Fees

- 3.1 The entry fee is \$50 ((\$5 discount for US Sailing members), payable to the Santa Cruz Yacht Club. A boat is not entered until her regatta fee is paid, and the entry form signed.

4 Registration and Schedules

- 4.1 The competitors meeting will be held Saturday April 26, 2008 at 1100 hours in the SCYC clubhouse.
- 4.2 The Warning Signal for the first race is scheduled for 1255 hours on Saturday 4/26/08. Six races are planned for the two days of racing. Three races are required for a Championship.

5 Measurement

- 5.1 All entrants are subject to measurement under per class rules.

6 Sailing Instructions

- 6.1 Sailing Instructions (SI's) will be available at the competitors meeting.

7 Venue and Courses

- 7.1 The course will be set using inflatable marks south of the Santa Cruz Harbor in the Monterey Bay. Course length will be plus or minus 60 minutes.
