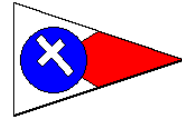

2008 SPRING SCORE/ DOUBLE HANDED SERIES

APRIL 27, MAY 25, AND JUNE 29, 2008

1 Rules

- 1.1 The series will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the 2008 SCYC Minimum Equipment Requirements (MER) as they apply to category 3 races for PHRF and category 4 races for double handed division, and the 2008 Spring Score / Double Handed Series Sailing Instructions.
- 1.2 US Sailing prescription to RRS 75.3 shall not apply.
- 1.3 The sailing instructions will alter RRS rule 40.1 to require adequate personal buoyancy be worn while racing.

2 Eligibility and Entry

- 2.1 Any boat holding a valid 2008 Monterey Bay PHRF or 2008 BAMA PHRF certificate. There will be PHRF divisions, a double handed division and a multi-hull division. PHRF divisions will be assigned at the Competitors meeting on Sunday April 27, 2008. Double handed division shall have exactly two persons on board. PHRF divisions shall have a minimum of two persons on board.
- 2.2 A boat is not entered until her regatta fee is paid and the entry form is signed.
- 2.3 At least two boats in a division must be in the starting area for that division to be given a warning signal.

3 Fees

- 3.1 Entry fees are payable to the Santa Cruz Yacht Club. Early entries (\$50) are due at SCYC by 1800 April 25, 2008. Regular entries (\$65) will be accepted at the SCYC Club House between 1000 and 1025 hours on Sunday April 27, 2008. A boat may enter for a single race day at any time prior to 1055 on the day of the race. One day entries (\$50) will not be eligible for trophies or the Champion of Champions regatta.

4 Schedule

- 4.1 A competitors meeting will be at 1030 hours on Sunday April 27, 2008.
- 4.2 The scheduled time of the warning signal is 1225 hours each race day.
- 4.3 Six races are scheduled. There will be two races each day.
- 4.4 Four races will constitute a series.

5 Sailing Instructions

- 5.1 The Sailing Instructions will be available at the competitors meeting.

6 Venue

- 6.1 Racing will be around temporary inflatable buoys or fixed buoys in Monterey Bay. The racing area is bounded by Moss Landing to the south east and as far as davenport and extending five miles off shore.

7 Courses

- 7.1 Courses will be distributed with the sailing instructions.

8 Prizes

- 8.1 Boats entered in classes with three (3) or more entries in the regatta are eligible for prizes or the Champion of Champions Regatta. One (1) award will be given for each three (3) boats entered, to a maximum of five (5). (3 entrants = 1 award, 6 entrants = 2 awards, 9 entrants = 3 awards, etc.).
